An Early Khmer Head of Vishnu

EXAMPLES of Cambodian sculpture of the "Early Khmer" period (sixth to eighth century A. D.) are nowhere abundant, and so far as I know the only piece in America is that recently presented to the Museum by Dr. Denman W. Ross. The head is in a hard bluish sandstone, slightly polished, and measures 24.6 cm. in height, headdress included. The latter is of the "mitre" type, and provided with projecting "wings." A headdress of this type, *en mitre*, is highly characteristic for Viṣṇu in early Khmer art. Another characteristic feature, and one not found in later
